Available to students graduating from Greater Saint John area high schools and post-secondary music students from Greater Saint John (within a fifty km. radius of Saint John Centre):

All applications **must** include this form (completed and signed), a handwritten letter explaining why you would be a suitable recipient, a transcript of previous marks and two (2) reference letters concerning your music-related endeavours (one reference from a teacher, professor, guidance counsellor or principal). Applications that are incomplete or do not include proper documentation will not be considered.

Applications must be submitted by May 31st.

The principal selection criteria are financial need, academic and musical achievement and participation in extracurricular and music-related activities. If, in the opinion of The Saint John Country Music Week Legacy Fund Selection Committee., no candidate completely satisfies all of the criteria in a given year, the bursary will not necessarily be awarded. The decision of the Board shall be final. All applicants, by signing, agree to these terms and conditions.
